

Niu Valley Middle School Dress Code Policy

(Effective August 4, 2010)

School ID Tag worn at ALL TIMES

- ID is property of Niu Valley Middle School.
- Keep your ID in good condition. If it becomes defaced or damaged, you will be required to purchase a new ID (\$5.00 charge applies).
- Your ID is for your use. Do not lend your ID to any other student for any reason.



- No hats, bandanas, headwear without brim. No headwear allowed indoors.
- No items of clothing or accessories that promote unacceptable behaviors and/or illicit drugs/substances.
- Shorts/skirts shall be no more than two inches above the top of the knee cap.
- Jeans/pants shall not have holes or tears in them above the kneecap.
- PE uniform pants are acceptable to wear during the school day.
- No writing on and no alterations (e.g. cutting, shredding) of uniforms.
- Uniforms shall be worn on campus including before and after school.

School Uniform Description

- School ID required.
- NVMS T-shirt, logo must be visible and cannot be covered with a pullover jacket or other shirt.
- Shorts, skirts, pants that conform to length requirements.
- Footwear required.
