**Important Dates**

- **Registration: (No early forms will be accepted)**  
**Registration for Enrichment Courses: March 28, 2017 – April 28, 2017**  
**Registration for Credit Recovery Courses: May 1, 2017 – May 26, 2017**  
Applications will be received on first-come first-served basis with priority given to incoming and returning students from Niu Valley Middle. Classes with insufficient enrollment will be cancelled and a refund will be issued.

**Tuition and Refunds**

**Credit Recovery Courses** - \$200 per course

**Drama Class with the Hawaii Opera Theatre** - \$200

**All other Enrichment Courses** - \$127

Registration forms and payment will be accepted between 7:30am - 4:30pm at the Administrative Office of Niu Valley Middle School. Cash or checks are accepted. Checks should be made payable to: Department of Education. Do not send cash via mail. A receipt of payment will be given to indicate acceptance into your chosen program.

Refunds are available based on DOE policy: Refunds will only be given prior to summer school starting.

**Student Schedule**

Students will receive their schedules on the first day of summer school at the orientation for all students. The orientation will be held on the first day of summer school at 8am in Niu Valley Middle School's Cafeteria, so please arrive at the school by 7:30 am.

**Course Offerings**

All classes run from 8am – 12 noon, unless otherwise noted. Classes are non-credit except for credit recovery courses.

**Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Graders**

- **Course 1: Enrichment Rotation** – This course selection consists of four one-hour courses where students rotate to different classrooms. This rotation is intended to support the transition of incoming 6<sup>th</sup> graders to our school. The rotation courses are subject to change, but currently consist of the following:
  - **Math Fundamentals**
  - **Art**
  - **Introduction to Band**
  - **PE and Fitness**
- **Course 2: Drama** (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade mixed, limited enrollment) – In collaboration with the Hawaii Opera Theatre we are offering a drama class where students will work with professional opera performers and musicians; culminating in an evening performance allowing students to experience what professional opera performers experience first hand. The course will consist of incoming 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders. Enrollment is limited. Students who are not admitted into this course may be enrolled into the Enrichment Rotation for 6<sup>th</sup> graders and receive refund of \$73, the difference in tuition between the Drama Course and Enrichment Course.

# Niu Valley Summer School 2017

## **Incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Graders**

- **Course 1: Advanced Band and Orchestra** – Students need prior approval from Mr. Fanning to register.
- **Course 2: Enrichment Rotation** (for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders only) – This course selection consists of four one-hour courses where students rotate to different classrooms. The rotation courses are subject to change, but currently consist of the following:
  - **ART World**
  - **Writing Fundamentals**
  - **Fitness**
  - **Explorations in History**
- **Course 3: Drama** (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade mixed, limited enrollment) – In collaboration with the Hawaii Opera Theatre we are offering a drama class where students will work with professional opera performers and musicians; culminating in an evening performance allowing students to experience what professional opera performers experience firsthand. The course will consist of incoming 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders. Enrollment is limited. Students who are not admitted into this course will be automatically enrolled into Course 2: Enrichment Rotation for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders and receive refund of \$73, the difference in tuition between the Drama Course and Enrichment Course.

## **Incoming 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Only**

- **Course 1: Advanced math preparation class / STEM.** Students need approval from Mrs. Sato or Ms. Principato

## **Credit Recovery**

- Forms available from the grade level counselors and in the main office.

## **Dress Code**

School uniforms are not required for Summer School. Students must wear footwear at all times. Any clothing that distracts or disturbs students from learning may need to be replaced by the parent/guardian. Shorts and skirts shall be longer than finger-tip length above the knee.

## **Lunch and Snacks**

The school will not provide lunch during the summer. Students may bring their own lunch or snacks.

## **Chapter 19: Student Misconduct and Discipline**

The Summer School Director or designee shall impose disciplinary action against any student attending summer school according to Chapter 19. Any student who commits a class A or class B offense shall be dismissed from summer school. A summer school student who commits two of any class C or D offense shall receive a warning for the first offense and may be released from summer school for the second offense. Students who are released from Summer School will not receive any tuition refunds.
